The Youth Now On Track Services (YNOT), the Government of Canada, and service providers of diverse communities across the GTA have joined together as collaborators in an important new project: helping our youth engage in capacity building and anti-racism education.

YNOT has created the **Heritage Capacity Building Project**, which consists of in-person and online workshops designed for youth on how to analyze and understand racism and discrimination as well as increase self-capacity in confronting inequality.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

- Weekly workshops for youth to attend and receive community service hours
- Workshops led by YNOT staff, volunteers, and service providers of diverse communities
- Working with community members and youth to address systemic issues

WHO IS Eligible

- Youth ages 14 to 24 years old
- Currently in school or not
- Folks of any background: race, ethnicity, gender, religion, household income, etc.
